Important Counselor Information

Because of the overwhelming response the UCC Conference and DOC Region continues to receive from persons interested in counseling Jr. High JANboree, the following information is important for you to read.

It is essential that the adult leadership for Jr. High JANboree consist of varied ages, backgrounds, experience and personalities, as well as, a balance of DOC and UCC representation. This includes the counseling staff. Because of this, **the directors have final approval of all counselors.**

- All counselors must be post high school and **at least** 18 years old. All counselors must agree to a cursory background check
- Adult youth leaders who are planning to attend Jr. High JANboree with youth from their congregation will receive first priority for counselor positions **until the Dec. 16th 2011 deadline.** After that, counselor positions will filled on a first come, first serve basis.
- Adult youth leaders are strongly encouraged to turn in registration forms ASAP, even if the youth from their church have not registered yet.
- Because of the fiscal responsibility the directors have to Loch Leven, the Conference and the Region, the number of counselor positions is determined by the number of campers for the event.
- Counselors selected will be required to submit to background investigation. A separate form will be emailed to all selected counselors for completion.
