The Ridge goes above and beyond to provide more than just basic care to our residents. We

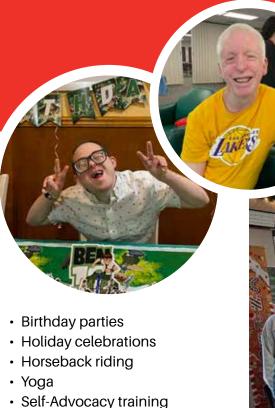
